The Dynamic of Mutual Approach and The Task of Spiritual Formation

At the beginning of a new Sunday School year, we can reflect on the task of spiritual formation. We begin with four texts. Please notice the word "draw":

The LORD appeared to me from afar [and said]: "I have loved you with an everlasting love. Therefore, I <u>draw</u> you faithfully along (Jeremiah 31:3).

"No one can come to me unless <u>drawn</u> by the Father who sent me" (John 6:44).

"And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will <u>draw</u> all people to myself" (John 12:32).

"Draw near to God and God will draw near to you" (James 4:8).

What we encounter in these Scriptures is movement toward each other on the part of God and individuals. Each party <u>draws</u> toward or is <u>drawn</u> toward the other. We can call this **the spiritual dynamic of mutual approach**.

I suggest that the task of spiritual formation is to cultivate this dynamic of mutual approach.
