I danced in the morning when the world was begun, and I dance in the moon and the stars and the sun, and I came down from heaven and I danced on the earth. At Bethlehem I had my birth.

I dance for the scribe and the Pharisee, but they would not dance and they wouldn't follow me; I danced for the fisherman, for James and John; they came to me and the dance went on.

Dance, then, wherever you may be, I am the Lord of Dance, said he. And I'll lead you all wherever you may be; and I'll lead you all in the dance, said he.

I danced on the Sabbath when I cured the lame, the holy people said it was shame; they whipped and they stripped and they hung me high; and they left me there on a cross to die.

I danced on a Friday and the sky turned black; it's hard to dance with the devil on our back; they buried my body and they thought I'd gone, but I am the dance and I still go on.

They cut me down and I leapt up high, I am the life that'll never, never die; I'll live in your if you live in me; I am the Lord of the Dance, said he.
