Kansas has 4 other DART affiliates in Lawrence, Topeka, Kansas City and Johnson County. Southern Hills Mennonite is involved in the Topeka affiliate. This organization is rooted in diverse faith traditions, who find common ground in values of justice and fairness. Since 1982, DART has trained over 10,000 community leaders and 270 professional community impacted organizers, who together have greatly their communities. Through the years, various affiliates worked on impactful solutions for their community concerning affordable housing, improving public transportation, job training, expanding health care, criminal justice and public education.
