Prayers for the wider church

...Pray for generous financial support for Western District Conference congregations and their ministries, and for the conference as it equips and connects with congregations and ministry leaders across the conference.

...This weekend, Mennonite Voluntary Service participants are beginning a week-long retreat at Amigo Centre in Michigan. Pray for their time of worship, fellowship, renewal and discernment, as they reflect on their time of service and learning and look forward to where God is calling them to next.

...The Evangelical Mennonite Church of Burkina Faso continues to grow, despite the violence and persecution that Christians in the country encounter.
