All in the April ev'ning, April airs were abroad; The sheep with their little lambs pass'd me by on the road. All in the April ev'ning I thought on the Lamb of God. "When You Believe"

Many nights we prayed with no proof anyone could hear. In our hearts a hopeful song we barely understood. Now we are not afraid, although there's much to fear.
